- The Cell will provide assistance for taking preventive steps in the matter of gender discrimination.
- 7. The Cell may form / review the guidelines / policy for redressal of the Grievance as required from time to time, which may be in accordance with those issued by Supreme Court and Government Agencies.
- The Cell will deal with the complaints of any type of harassment or any other of the female students teaching and non-teaching women staff of the college.
- The Cell shall process all the individual complaints and take immediate Suitable action.

- Female students and staff give their Grievance in the form of letter Oral to the any Committee member of the cell.
- After knowing the grievance of the students or staff, the Committee discusses it with concerned HOD and principal to take appropriate solution.
- Any member found to have harassed another member or guest will be subject to appropriate disciplinary procedure action, including warnings, suspension or termination of membership.
- 13. The cell will meet at least once every academic year .Other than that, emergency meeting shall be called on receipt of a complaint. The quorum for the meeting should be at least one third of the total members




